Have you prayed for blessings, cast the worries and pressures away and stay excited to receive it. God is looking at you to see how excited you are this remaining days of 2021. **Welcome to your season of wonders in Jesus name.**

TEXT: (2 Chronicle 17 vs. 10-11), (Matthew 7 vs. 8)

To live in jealousy is equal to living in jeopardy. **To be unhappy when others are progressing is equal to witchcraft.** Putting effort to sponsor someone's limitation is equal to generational damage. God's word to us today says, *"For everyone that asketh recieveth: and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened"*. This principle is not limited to the white or black but to every race, everyone, small or great. As a child of God, the most that can happen in your mind while you witness others progress should be **"Father, I claim this, do it for me as you did it for my brother or sister"**. Years ago there was a boy who was very brilliant and a son to a teacher who taught in the same school where he was schooling. Due to the progress in the academic career of this young boy some of the teachers in the same school conspired against him; saying he was found trying to lie with a girl at the back of the school. It went as they planned; due to the level of the persons involved and the evidences they were able to produce the boy was expelled from the school. You can imagine the kind of heart break it may have caused the mother who was a teacher in the same school. It doesn't exalt to plan or seek for someone else's downfall. Though God has given us seasons of peace as regards this vision but I won't be surprised to see someone or persons trying to paint it black. The point is plain: Whenever anyone tries to become a hindrance to someone God has lifted, God himself hinders you. 20 years has passed and all the children are no longer in secondary school or struggling over who comes first or last. Most of them have gotten married and life continued. It was around this time (after 20 years) that the same person who has championed the accusation found his way to reach the young man on the phone saying, **"From that day till today, I have remained confused, frustrated and limited."** Obviously he was forgiven but imagine what the opinion of God towards him is. God's word reprimanded us today in verse 10 of our first scripture saying, *"The fear of God is the source of peace, to every agent of discord the Lord will oppose and resist"*. Pray in the Holy Ghost.

**Prayer Points: Worship God using song 3: Page 122**

2. Pray for the grace to be happy with yourself.
3. Father, I kill any spirit of jealousy in me in Jesus name, Amen!
4. Oh God as I am rejoicing over the good in other people's life do great things for me in Jesus name, Amen!

TEXT: (Genesis 25 vs. 28-34), (Genesis 27 vs. 30-36)

Though we are not meant to dwell in the past but the past should live in our today's decisions. On behalf of the Holy Spirit I extend my hand of greetings to you. The most terrible mistake anyone can make is to neglect and ignore his past. Jesus died in the past many years ago, yet by his death salvation is valid till today. *"And he said, is not he rightly named Jacob? For he hath supplanted me these two times: he took away my birth-right; and, behold now, he hath taken away my blessings..."* (Verse 36 of today's second scripture). At the point of considering this passage I began to ask myself, **"So Esau was really aware he sold his birth-right for just a plate of food and still hoped to get the blessing attached to it?"** God brings the past forward. Never forget that today isn't just a day but the past of your future and will determine the future you will see. Some persons are still undergoing the same trial because they have determined to overlook their past. Some persons clearly entered into the wrong marriage because they neglected their past. It may appear difficult to reach your desired height this year if you do not bring your past years together and resolve what should be resolved. The past is not just for witness but for lessons.

Look at this: if someone was poisoned in a particular place once and he escaped, and returning later in the future, he is told that the same suspect who had poisoned him has now become a priest; but then not to considering the past the so-called priest offers him food and he dies of it, isn't the individual a fool? We are not doubting the power of God that transforms but we are not to render trust on the platform of pretence. It will not be foreign if we witness the reemergence of network businesses like MMM, Ultimate Cycle and the likes, and among the victims may be those who lost millions to the business the last time. God is saying to someone that in order to avoid regrets this season build your today from the lessons of your past. Sit and think of the past in relation to the present. May we be wise.

**Prayer Points: Worship God using your own songs.**

1. Oh God I thank you today for your word to me.
2. Jesus give me the grace to learn what you want me to learn today.
3. Father I ask for the grace to be who you have called me to be.

TEXT: (Job 29 vs. 20-25), (Psalm 81 vs. 10)

I welcome you to the field of the Most High God. Someone said, "Maturity is the ability to think, speak and act your feelings within the bounds of dignity. The measure of your maturity is how spiritual you become during the midst of your frustration. Another said, **"Speak up because the day you don't speak up for the things that truly matter to you is the day your freedom truly ends"**. God has planted the most powerful tool of survival in the tongue. Your understanding that words live has the capacity to guide your language or word usage. It doesn't matter what is not right around you, if you have the right word in place you will surely step up to greatness.

An associate of this vision was once broke and very poor but he kept mentioning to my hearing that God has promised him saying, "If I didn't make you a multi-millionaire then know that I am not God". Today He is a millionaire. You can't change your life or situation above what you have proclaimed with your mouth. (Proverb 18 vs. 20): **"A man's belly shall be satisfied with the fruits of his mouth; [and] with the increase of his lips shall he be filled."** Normally a man's belly is meant to be satisfied with the fruits of his labour but instead God's word says, is with the fruits of the mouth. Therefore it doesn't just matter what the labour is; to be productive the mouth should sound productive as well. On many occasions I have seen people with terminal diseases but with the proclamation of their lips they survived remarkably. God is telling you today to position your lips aright. Maybe what you planned this year is not coming as planned; arrest them with your mouth. Announce what you want to see around you to the hearing of a witness. I heard that one rich bishop was once staying in a one room apartment with six roommates but on the wall was written "I shall never be poor". Remember that already he was living poor but the content of lips disagreed with the reality of his life then. God's word on our today's second scripture urges us to open our mouth wide and God will fill it with words of faith. Job also testified of how he gathered strength from the words he spoke. Say something about your next level today.

**Prayer Points: Worship God using song 2: Page 121**

1. Oh God I thank you for your word to me.
2. Jesus fill my mouth with the words my destiny needs.
3. Father as I speak may my life drive in that direction (Go ahead and speak).
4. Oh God may I be conscious never to **4** when I need to speak.

TEXT: (Romans 5 vs. 1-8), (Ephesians 2 vs. 4)

Having the full knowledge of God's love is a secret behind a successful life on earth and hope of eternal glory in heaven. Just like we have read in the past about how Abraham was willing to sacrifice Isaac his son to God with pain in his heart and wounds in his mind, yet he decided to take Isaac to the sacrificial Altar. You will recall that Isaac was his only child around by then because Ishmael had gone far away with his mother, never to be traced or found again by Abraham. Yet Abraham because of the fear of God that was in him was willing to give God his very last love. I just caught a rhema from the Holy Spirit. Remember that God addressed Abraham as the father of many nations (Genesis 17 vs. 4). He also promised Abraham saying, *"Thy seed shall possess the gates of his enemies"* (Genesis 22 vs. 17). At that point in history Abraham sowed a seed of his last love to God and God being the one who does not allow seeds to fade or die responded to Abraham's seed by giving His very last love to Abraham's children/seed (Father of many nations). He (God) became flesh and dwelt among the generations of Abraham living as a reward of Abraham's seed (John 1 vs. 14). God didn't merely give out His son for mankind but he gave out Himself; that's His last love. God's word is specific in today's first scripture verse 8 when it says, "But God commandeth his love towards us, in that while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us". Do you get something there? He commandeth his Love. So I am loved by God by His own command not on the bases of my goodness or badness. Never submit yourself to the mockery of the devil telling you what you deserve from God and what you don't deserve; just remind him that God's love upon you is unconditional. Do you believe in Jesus? If yes, then you deserve all the benefits his love offers. (John 3 vs. 16): "...Whosoever believe in him should not perish, but have everlasting life". If God loves you, then he releases for you. Abraham Loved God and a lamb was released to him for sacrifice. God loves you and He released Himself for the sacrifice. I guess you already know that inside of Him is all you seek in life.

TEXT: (Proverb 15 vs. 14-23)

When Nelson Mandela was studying law in the university a white professor, whose last name was Peter, disliked him intensely. One day Mr Peter was having lunch at the dining room when Mandela came along with his tray and sat next to him. The professor said, "Mr Mandela you do not understand a pig and a bird do not sit together to eat". Mandela looked at him as a parent would look at a rude child and calmly replied, "You do not worry professor, I will fly away." and he went and sat at another table. Mr Peter filled with rage, decided to take revenge. The next day in class he posed the following question: "Mr Mandela, if you were walking down the street and found a package, and within was a bag of wisdom and another bag with money, which one would you take? Without hesitating, Mandela responded, "The one with money of course". Mr Peter smiling sarcastically said, "I, in your place would have taken the wisdom". Nelson Mandela shrugged and responded, "Each one takes what he doesn't have". Mr Peter by this time was about to throw a fit seething with fury. So great was his anger that he wrote on Nelson Mandela's sheet the word "IDIOT" and gave it out. Mandela took the exam sheet and sat down at his desk trying very hard to remain calm while he contemplated his next move. A few minutes later Nelson got up, walked up to the professor and told him in a dignified polite tone, "Mr Peter, you signed up your name on the sheet but you forgot to give me my grade". To be able to create wonders, smart responses are needed. My major interest was not just Nelson's responses but the boldness he got to respond in such manner to a professor in his course of pursuit. We need such boldness to say what is to be said especially for God's messengers. I agree that's why God's word says in 2 Timothy 1 vs. 7, "For God hath not given us the spirit of fear but of power, and of love, and of sound mind." Just like the professor was trying to make Nelson feel inferior and unprivileged that's how satan tries to limit your speed this year by suggesting false representations of you. Aiming to make you feel unmerited to get what you deserve. Reply Him with the wisdom of God's word. From all Nelson said, he didn't insult the professor or abuse him but replied him from the content of his own idea. May God give you the right word against the accusations and limitation of the devil. Meditate on verse 23 of today's scripture.

TEXT: (James 5 vs. 10-12), (Matthew 5 vs. 37)

Today's second scripture says, "But let your communication be yea, yea; Nay nay: for whatsoever that is none of these cometh of evil." It is often considered an act of intelligence to lure people into what they never accepted/wanted because the individual involved moves from something familiar to an unwanted destination making a victim of their mind puzzle game. A young man mistakenly transferred two hundred thousand (out of two hundred and ten thousand balance) from his account to another's, and after thinking of a way to stop the person from withdrawing the money; he came up with the idea of sending a message to the person's phone. The message read "Hello dark and worthy initiate, I hope you are okay. I believe you have received the money I sent to you. It's for your initiation into the eternal mystical order of glorious satanism in the Ogboni fraternity scheduled to take place at midnight. The money I sent is only for your transport. I will send you more for shopping. There are riches awaiting you in the kingdom. Two weeks after the initiation a family member close to your heart will die, this will unlock your ticket to wealth and you will have the ability to fly at night to any part of the world. Thanks for complying in advance but in case you are not ready to join, please send back the money immediately to avoid your sudden death."

Few minutes later, he got an sms saying,

.God is saying to someone, "Why not be plain and straightforward. The major limitation some persons have is the inability to be plain. My plainness of speech makes people to hate me, and what is hatred but a proof that I am speaking the truth (Plato). The Spirit is bringing to someone's understanding that it is better to sound weird being plain than to sound hopeful but also deceitful. There are people who are sure that they don't want a particular thing and still they hang around it. When you condemn something publicly and harbour it secretly, it is a sign of hypocrisy. Be known for plainness. Say "No" today and remain with your "No" tomorrow except for better reasons.

**TEXT: (Job 24 vs. 13-24)**

Reduction of anything positive attracts no value or respect. People are mostly celebrated for how far they have increased. I understood that people are reduced from their mind before they are reduced outwardly. In God's kingdom there is no space for reduction. For we are placed far above principalities and powers in heavenly places (Ephesians 2 vs. 6). When the character of a Christian does not speak Christ it causes reduction. God has planned to exalt men but most persons have decided not to agree with him by living the life that contradicts His nature. Imagine how absurd it sounds that a so-called pastor slept with a member or abused a woman; such things result in reduction of person and esteem. Some of the reason why we struggle to maintain a Christ-like reputation/lifestyle is not because we fear God alone but also because we consider the image we will manifest when we behave contrarily. Everyone has feelings, urges and so on as the case may be. The cells responsible for human behaviour aren't spiritual and requires we suppress them by purposely imbibing modest character. Paul the Apostle said, *"I bring myself under subjection"* (1 Corinthians 9 vs. 27). God in His wisdom revealed in verse 13 of today's scripture saying, *"They are of those that rebel against the light; they know not the ways thereof, nor abide in the path thereof."* Christianity promotes esteem but Christianity without character results in shame. The devil does not seduce anyone, he does not persuade anyone to commit sin but he sponsors lust to develop in persons until they move away from God by themselves. Lift your hand and say with me: "Jesus, give me the grace to live for you." It is a dangerous thing to be reduced. One may struggle to keep a sin secret but at least a person (your sin partner) is aware that you are reduced in character. "You must regret your character when your character contradicts the personality you are determined to display." (Isaac Chidolue).

**TEXT: (Psalm 126 vs. 1 – 6)**

TEXT: (Genesis 3 vs. 1 – 7)

Satan was trying to project the coding of God on the system earth where man exist. Trying to tap into the unapproachable mind of God in balance to human philosophy. God in response to this desire of spiritual dialogue between man and the suggesting spirit around his environment said in (Isaiah 55 vs. 8): *"For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, saith the Lord"*. Food for thought: What inspires what you read?

What mind-set do the knowledge you seek communicate? God bless you!

**Prayer Points: Worship God using your own songs.**

1. Oh God I thank you for your word to me.
2. Father, May I seek what I needed to seek and know what I needed to know.
3. Jehovah, be my help and my guide, every now and then in Jesus name, Amen!

TEXT: (Genesis 3 vs. 1 – 7) repeated scripture

*"For God knows that in the day you eat of it your eyes shall be opened, and you will be like God, knowing good and evil"* (Genesis 3 vs. 5). One of our associates one day playing carelessly went into a particular site on the internet after registering his name alone, no address added. The site congratulated him, not long a book was dropped at the mail box of his address from that site/group. It was an occult book though he panicked and called me. I saw the book, took it, and held it. As I was going to minister that day I threw it inside a gutter. In continuation of today's study, *"For God doeth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil"*. *"...in the day ye eat thereof"*. A promise of time of change. Whenever the devil wants to engineer a capital, he refers to a future. The day you eat thereof. Every act or shift from God comes with a promise that is anchored on time. After robbing, I will have this and that. **Never you fall for the promiscuity of the devil.** Don't be a victim of satanic harassment that is done from the place of limitation. *"Then your eyes shall open"*. This was a categorical statement that limits the comprehension of a man. The question is, was Adam and Eve's eyes closed? They saw themselves and could even see God anytime He appears. After Adam saw Eve for the first time, he said this is the bone of my bone and the flesh of my flesh too. When God comes for visit, they see him, but satan suggested a deficiency to them. What you consider as a need, may not really be a need if not that the devil suggested a deficiency in your mind to a need that does not really exist. He was telling those who could see spiritually and physically that their eyes will open. Unfortunately for them he made them blind instead, because after that they were scared to look at God. Food for thought: **"Could it be that the trouble you face was just a need that does not exist but suggested by the devil."**

**Prayer Points: Worship God using song 5: Page 124**

1. Oh God I thank you for your word to me.
2. Jesus, help me to be right at all times with my life decisions.
3. Oh God, today I close every lope hole created around me by the devil.

TEXT: (Acts 10 vs. 40-48), (1 Corinthians 14 vs. 39)

I welcome you today to the sanctuary of the Almighty God. *“He that speaketh in an unknown tongue edifieth Himself,”* (1 Corinthians 14 vs. 4). Tongues speaking isn't just a means of reaching God, it is not also just a means to identify the Holy Spirit in a life but it is an inducer of God's charge and power. What's the reason why anyone could prefer speaking in tongues? When you pray in tongues according to the utterance of the Spirit you touch areas and places you couldn't have touched ordinarily; you bring God's power to the system. “...for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groaning which cannot be uttered” (Romans 8 vs. 26). It is the right of every child of God to pray in the Holy Ghost. Holy Ghost baptism isn't a different call or initiation; when anyone dwells in Christ and lives in Him then the individual is exposed and revealed to the Holy Ghost. It was the Holy Spirit that sponsored the resurrection of Christ and revived his disfigured body which you and I are part of. This is the evidence that every one of us is exposed to the Holy Spirit, what some of us need is just to tarry! Yes, tarry until you are endued with power (Luke 24 vs. 49). I was not prayed for to be Holy Ghost baptised, I just received it and spoke in tongues while praying. A sister who attended one of our Prayer Network some years back testified that after the prayers she caught the Holy Ghost without knowing though the servant of God prayed a special prayer for her with the release of the Holy Ghost upon her. She went home to pray as usual but spoke in tongues and the power of God was unusual and raw that it brought her sister down and her mother was healed of leg poison instantly. I can remember when I was younger, an occasion when my phone got faulty and the screen was malfunctioning. I held it in my hands and prayed in tongues for twenty minutes, and Bam! It was well and revived. You possess power in God by the Holy Ghost. Until you see what He does through you, you may not believe much in Him. Seeing today's second scripture it says, *“Wherefore, brethren covet to prophesy, and forbid not to speak with tongues”*. You are called to pray in the Holy Ghost irrespective of what your church thinks. Forbid not to speak in tongues.

TEXT: (Isaiah 43 vs. 1 – 3)

There is a point in someone's life where the future is decided at the now. **Neglected quest to make things right on behalf of the coming time could result to damages that cannot be ordinarily managed.** There is a wisdom of God that helps one to walk in alignment to glory. A brother mistakenly sent a message to an army general and then contacted him to apologise that it was really a mistake, with fear that he had done the worst he could ever do. Then the general invited him to his office and offered him a job, meanwhile the brother has been trusting God for Job all those while. God turned his situation around using his own mistakes. The best way to have the future you dream in your hand is to be a prayer person. When you graciously dwell in the place of prayers your future is guaranteed, as long as you are ready to carry out the actions that sponsors the process. To those who knows how to call on God, there is a confidence they walk with into a place of happening and the future. It takes a spiritual eyes of faith to become hopeful when every other thing suggests differently. One of the things the spirit of God does for a man is to keep him going, when going forward is difficult to maintain. Yes, the Holy Spirit is there when you felt you have failed and does not have any other reason to continue your walk of fellowship and commitment to God. I understand that Jehovah wants to credit someone's mind with His strong assurance, that even in the burning flames I will be with you. It is not a prophecy to know that there is someone somewhere who is reading through the pages of this COF who feels like giving up the vision and target of God on His life but God is saying I am He who carries you, not the other way round. The future you are running to is the past I have been 'in'. Digest verse 2B of today's scripture where it says, *“When thou walkest through the fire, thou shalt not be burned; neither shall the flames kindle upon thee”*.

TEXT: (Mark 6 vs. 30-32)

Life is in phases and no phase will blossom without the maximum support of the other. We mostly emphasize on the need to move, work and act but little have we spoken on the need to take a break and rest. Once a preacher said,

“Though the Lord has given me the anointing, I am laid at a place unable to impact it on lives because I have worked out my life so early, unable to distinguish when to rest and when to work; though I have the anointing, my body is the possessor of it and as it is weak what else is the essence of the anointing.”

Someone else said, **“Grow through, what you go through.”**

I have learnt that sometimes it is better to take a break in whatsoever you do; by so doing you are refreshed to affect lives with better ideas. Even in the civil service there are provisions for a paid leave, why work yourself out? I work so hard in a day that sometimes I keep record of sleeping only for 2 hours out of the 24 hours that makes a day; it drains energy and sometimes might affect health but I have learnt that it is better to plan well than working long. The word 'Rest' appeared 275 times in the scripture. When you divide the number with 5 you will have 55. It takes almost 55 weeks to make a year. If I should make a theory with this I will recommend that an average individual should rest at least 5 hours a day and work within 5 days a week. It is necessary that a day of rest should be mapped out in your weekly activities, very essential also there should be a period of rest in a day. There should also be a season of holiday, it could be a week, it could be in days but observe enough rest. The better you work the better you become but the smarter you work the faster and happier you become. When God was talking about rest He wasn't insisting that you should sleep, he is trying to bring your attention to all that surrounds you. Give attention to your wife, children and family at large. As a Pastor make out time to rest and surprise your home. Go and see a movie together though you can get any in your home. Prepare a meal for your family. Take your wife out as you used to do before you both got married. Sit down and then move. When you give yourself enough rest then you will jump into work with better enthusiasm and you will achieve better and smarter. If you have the money go abroad just for holiday. Your life is the reason why you are working so enjoy the fruits of your labour. Digests this: **“Don't dream your life, live your dreams.”** (Isaac Chidolue)

TEXT: (Hebrew 3 vs. 1 – 3)

Glory be to God who has brought us to the place of His glory. The place of wisdom is the place of knowledge. **Men who are knowledge oriented are great custodians of wisdom.** To be mindful of knowledge is to treasure the place of wisdom. Men who are classic in their godly nature are the real custodians of knowledge. Once a wise man in China was approached by a young boy who was holding a butterfly. In the young boy's mind he said, he was going to test the wise man. When he got there he said to the wise man, “Tell me if the butterfly in my hand lives or not. The wise man after laughing for a while replied him saying, “If I tell you that the butterfly is dead, you will release your hand for it to fly, but if I tell you that the butterfly lives then you press it to death in your palm, hence the life of the butterfly is in your hands anyhow you do it. Wisdom is in the hand of the person living. Yes it is always in our hand to take advantage of the moment in wisdom. Wisdom is found both in the life and imagination of the wise, any wise fellow, lives with a vibrant imagination of wisdom. The path of wisdom ignores the place of ignorance. When you see people who so much rely in what they know, and what they can do, it become the beginning of limitation on their path. For the wise is reactive to knowledge and is always willing to learn new things at every point in time. **If you think that God is not an instructor of knowledge then you are wrong.** It is always important and paramount that one should learn and always learn, until the individual is certain he has acquired certain knowledge to triumph in his endeavour. Never play, the card of ignorance, it cost more than it takes at the moment. Verse 2 of today's scripture says, *“Who was faithful to him that appointed him as also Moses was faithful in all his house”*. This is a clear evidence that Jesus literally studied the faithful pattern of Moses and walked on it. Moses two hands was lifted by a stone for his people to gain victory, Jesus hand was spread on the cross of Calvary. for man's victory Assignment: **Study and read godly books.**

Everything in life is circled within opportunities. David prayed and started a journey without a destination. They would have passed the Egyptian after all Egypt is very far away and should not be in the list of his suspect; but he picked up the man. Brethren, opportunities most times appears in disguise. It doesn't come with appointment but meets one who is in a journey to accomplish a mission. Verse 13 of today's scripture reveals, *"And David said unto him, to who belongest thou? And whence art thou? And he said, I am a young man of Egypt, servant to an Amalekite; and my master left me, because three days ago I fell sick"*.

Lift your hand and say after me, **"Oh Lord give me opportunities, provide access for me and help me to recognise one no matter how disguised it may look, in Jesus name, Amen!"**

**James E** rang a bell when he said, "Some of our important choices have a time line. If we delay a decision, the opportunity is gone forever. Sometimes our doubts keep us from making choices that involve change. Thus, an opportunity may be missed." God has planted your testimonies this 2021 within the opportunities that come your way. To him that will utilize an opportunity his first move is to recognise that there is an opportunity. Don't procrastinate an opportunity, pray and ask God for it and in a short time an opportunity emerges. The expensive truth is that opportunities often go when there is a delay in using them. Oh that is the mind Syrus had when he said, **"The opportunity is often lost by deliberating."**

Find the purpose of your marriage, find the need behind your friendship, everyone around us serves for an opportunity. Spark it up like David did with the Egyptian.

**When you see an opportunity don't walk over it except it is against the will of God, except it will displease God.** (Continues later)

It is necessary that one understands the place of God in matters and events of life. Greatness is possible from every realm of life. Achievement is equally possible but the truth is that the individual involve in the pursuit of success should walk within the knowledge and understanding of the fact that since God excels, it is His will to see them excel as well. It is absolutely God's choice that you will excel. One of the things a believer should have at the back of his mind is the knowledge that God already wants and wishes that you excel in any area of your pursuit. To achieve excellence is not a product of luck, it is a product of repeated effort until what is needed is achieved. Today's first scripture opened God's concept to us when it says, *“Thou art more glorious and excellent than the mountain of prey”* (KLV). *“Oh Lord, how bright you shine! Outshining their huge piles of loots!”*(MSG). I don't know if you captured something right now. It says, how bright our God is, out shining their huge piles of loot! There is no genuine excuse of whatsoever before a child of God too reasonable enough to satisfy the need to relaxation and acceptance of the low place. Sometimes life could be showing its mean face around but from the mind-set and insight of God's nature which a believer is believed to have, the individual is expected to shine brighter always. The scripture says, **“He outshines their huge pile of loot!”** This reveals that whatsoever the thief stole to keep you below, to enrich himself and pile for himself, by the virtue of God's nature and character which you posses, you will outshine and outsmart them all, as the Lord will grant you grace in Jesus name, Amen! Amen!

TEXT: (Daniel 10 vs. 8-12)

“The game of life is a lot like football. You have to tackle your problems, block your fears, and score your goal when you get the opportunity” (Lewis Grizzard). I want to remind someone that it is very essential to note that May is our month of ACCESS. For days now God has been taking us through the lines that can enlighten us with ideas on how to access our paths of greatness. Today's scripture verse 12 says, “*Fear not Daniel: for from the first day that thou didst set thine heart to understand, and to chasten thyself before thy God, thy words were heard, and I am come for thy words*”. Note this: “*Set thine heart to understand, and to chasten thyself before thy God!*” God is asking a user of this COF; right now at this point where is your heart? What are you aiming at? I have understood that life is all about accomplishing the desires of the heart. It is fulfilling the wants in the mind. Once anybody achieves an outstanding goal, another one lines up on the line. Whatever you dream this year may be it is essential you realise that to hit the target is your aim. A lot has come and gone; It doesn't matter who rules your nation, Jesus rules you! God's word speaking in Proverb 10 vs. 24 says, “... *but the desire of the righteous shall be granted*”. It is a desire, for Daniel he placed his heart on his desire, whatever that is not desired is not qualified to be achieved. Desire is not a choice, it is synonymous to hunger. It attracts focus and specification. It calls for steadiness and approach. When you set a goal before you, channel your days to its actualization. Don't just begin the year by just saying I will get married this year. What's your plan? How much have you prayed about it? And how far have you read about it too? As a man what's your move? The joy of accomplishment eats up the process of it. Whatever you aim, go for it. What is your desire this year? How far have you gone with it? I recommend you note this: “**I am only one, but I am one. I cannot do everything, but I can do something. And because I cannot do everything, I will not refuse to do the something that I can do.**” (Edward Evereth Hale). Set your goals today; write them down, bring your task within weeks and write down the time of accomplishment as you accomplish them daily, especially if you are into production.

TEXT: (Isaiah 50 vs. 4)

One of the things I personally enjoy is the story and testimony of successful individuals who succeeded by God's support and sponsorship. **As an individual who is really mindful of success; you must be sure of the proceeds of your lips.** You should not be found in the company of people who mock others. It is only a fool that draws a conclusion from the happenings of the moment. Life is advancing and generates a different bases every now and then, and wisdom is justify by the utilization of now in individual's movements and impacts pointing to the view point of destination arrival of success. To stand in a man's limitation with hope of referencing mockery is to come to the place of glory degeneration and life's limitation. I once heard from a Pastor about how another Pastor was speaking to him years back mocking their Church's generator as a Creket generator; of course the Pastor who was mocked is now the Pastor with the biggest auditorium as long as that environment is concerned and beyond. I have seen people whose mouth are without caution. Mouths that speaks in tongue and prays in thunder but has no godly restriction in mocking people before their eyes. There are people that once they enters a person's house they will access everywhere and end up with a frustrating statement that will make the other person feel inferior. These kind of people hardly speak good of anything they see. Godliness is found on the usage of the tongue. Be careful not to be part of people's ugly story when they share it, never mock anyone because of the present situation they are in because situation changes and nobody stays low forever. The person who drives an outdated car knows that it is outdate, why do you have to remind him? Many times I passed vehicles that are looking old, with a good church sticker or clergy post on them, many times I feel touched that immediately I will begin to pray saying, “Lord, for the sake of who you are, please change this car for your servant who has it”. Recently I was in a public transport and the vehicle stopped to drop someone in front of an old house but was newly painted for burial or something, I unconsciously prayed saying, “Lord, for this family, turn things around”. See verse 4 of today's scripture, “The Lord God has given the voice of the learned, that I should know how to speak a word in season to him that is weary:” **Immaturity in God is when your word as a believer comes outside your wisdom.**

**Prayer Points: Worship God using song 5: Page 124**

TEXT: (Ephesians 2 vs. 1-7), (Psalm 23 vs. 6)

Yes, you deserve the mercy of God. God's mercy is not bought, God's mercy cannot be exhausted. God's mercy does not regulate limit (One can receive as much as infinity can carry). God's mercy cannot be diluted. It has no side effect. It has no abuse. God's mercy is the part of God that does not segregate from anything. It can adapt with holiness and flourishes in an unholy place. God's mercy is the part of God that does not judge and it is at the reception of salvation. Yes, the nature of God is in His mercy. It is only by His mercy that we deserve heaven and just by His mercy we will get there. I believe we saw verse 4 of today's first scripture where it says, ***“But God who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith He loved us”***. Your knowledge of God's mercy is the file that will determine the height you will get to in life. People love God but only by His mercy will they please Him and be like Him. I came across a news item recently which reported that a Nebraska man's children said their final goodbye and made the difficult decision to pull the plug after their father was declared brain dead by doctors, But the “Miracle Man” (Jesus) had different plans. The man who was concluded brain dead and was recommended to be left dead said, 'I am not an extremely religious person but I believed in God. I believed in Jesus with all my heart. And now this is just proof for me that everything I have heard is true. That He loves me, that he is right there for me. He gave me a miracle.

Wherever you are today, never imagine that your effort has brought you there, for it is only by His mercy that we are not consumed (Lamentation 3 vs. 22). It is by His mercy that we write COF, it is by His mercy that we produce them, by His mercy it is circulated, by His mercy we are alive to be reading it, and it is only by His mercy have we encountered God on the pages of it. When next someone is trying to accuse you like the devil does, tell him **“God's mercy has not left my hands.”** I tell you by God's mercy you will end this year with glorious testimonies. You will achieve God's trust in and purpose for your life

TEXT: (1 Kings 12 vs. 1 – 16)

The manner at which people responds to sudden arrows of question, speaks more of their nature, being unprepared to get such question coming. I welcome you before the one who is considered as the all wise God. Verse 14 of today's scripture says, *“My father made your yoke heavy, and I will add to your yoke: My father also chastised you with whips, but I will chastise you with scorpions”*. Apart from the fact that the scripture said Rehoboam was counselled by his fellows young men, I was asking myself so he wasn't able to inherit his father's wisdom. The rude rhymes of the word above; believing that someone rehearsed it, listened to himself and then agreed to speak to a congregation; it is really difficult to digest. This period God is asking someone to be mindful of what he says. People's mind, thought, conscience and ideas are not known but a spoken word communicates all those. This is why it was said that silence has never been wrong and guilty because no one can quote it. When Frank Nwoke was the Minister of information in Nigeria during President Olushegun Obasanjo's administration. He was interviewed by Journalist after the plane crash of Sosoliso plane 2005. The journalist asked him to confirm to the press if some VIPs were involved in the plane crash, he said, **“Everybody everywhere is a VIP to someone somewhere”**. This was a statement so much admired that it would be written on a space of gold. The value and regard your word gives to humanity determines the outcome you can attract out of life. By the word of Rehoboam Israel scattered that day, His throne and kingdom was reduced to one. 12 cities and tribes left him. **Sometimes those you think you are helping are actually the pillars behind your stand.** Sometimes those you are nagging on, especially on a leadership platform are not slaves but individuals who willingly submitted to your leadership. **No one is guilty as much as being abused with words.** What do you say to your friend, colleague, spouse, child and servants? If you speak to any as less human, repent today.

TEXT: (Ecclesiastes 3 vs. 7 – 11)

I welcome you to this divine assisted source of grace. Many times some persons are wearied to frustration from a place of prayers. Some persons have called God in different dimension and channel of prayers expecting Him to answer. In the midst of many frustrations surrounding individuals who have prayed at one time or the other, could we conclude that God does not answer prayers? Have any of your prayers been answered in the past? If yes, is your answer, then it shows that you are a witness that God really answer prayers. The question now is, what can we say of those situations where answers haven't come yet. Could it be that God cannot answer them or is it that He cannot do them? I believe this will now lead to the question of what is it that God cannot answer, or what is it that God cannot do. Of course there are many things God cannot do. He cannot lie, (Numbers 23 vs. 19), God cannot stand in unison with iniquity, God cannot mind who was attached to sin, that was one of the reasons why He forsook Jesus on the cross (Psalm 99 vs. 9). God cannot forget the labour of love (Hebrew 6 vs. 10). God cannot dishonour those that honour Him. This is a reminder for individuals who are praying for the downfall of people that honours God. (1 Samuel 2 vs. 30). There are prayers not answered because it is against the nature and purpose of God for the individual praying. Prayer cannot result to situations that will shift you from God rather it will make you to fit-in to God's nature and standard. *"You ask and receive not because you ask amiss that you may consume it upon your won lusts"* (James 4 vs. 3). But whosoever that prays for any matter trusting God should be able to digest the concept of believing in God. Knowing that He hears, there should be no struggle trying to communicate to the one who hears and is available compared to the deaf. So if you spoke to God know that He heard as you expect answers. Digest verse 11A of today's scripture, ***"He hath made everything beautiful in his time..."*** God is a specific beautifier and the Almighty one.

TEXT: (Psalm 4 vs. 1 – 5)

When God finds a man trusted, He is ever ready to lay upon such man the outstanding glory of excellence to triumph in life. How much of God can you bear for the kingdom? What is your place of giving up? Where does your strength end? Where is the point where hope has gone from you? There are situations when it is hard to trust people you have surrounded yourself with, but sometimes we still have to trust irrespective of the circumstances surrounding it to be broken. Someone said, ***"Trust has to be earned, and should come only after the passage of time"***. It is time that builds and maintains trust. There was a couple who was barren after they had gotten married. The wife was consistent in church, appearing in most church programs and activities. One of the occasions the husband began to threaten to pursue the wife out of his house, when some brothers got there to reconcile issues between them. It was gathered from the man while he was sharing his experience, he said that they have been to different evil altars, native doctors, shrines and many other places in solution of a child but no child came. Meanwhile brothers have been fasting out their lives mentioning the faithfulness of the sister to God, so He God can look at her commitment not knowing that sister was not singing in the same rhyme with them. Verse 5 of today's scripture says, ***"Offer the sacrifice of righteousness, and put your trust in the Lord"***. There are sacrifices to make. Sometimes proving your heart to God require sacrifice. It is sacrificial for a sister to hold unto all the godly recommendation waiting for the right man God is sending without breaking the code of trust. I don't know if you actually trust yourself to trust God enough. Personally I only put my faith in God. Keeping the faith coming. It is sacrificial for brother to be broke, having opportunities of evil money but saw necessity in trusting God.

To be highly recommended by God you must come to the point where self is dead and God is exalted. To that very place where your glory means nothing to you. Coming to the realisation that you are the least if not for God's sake. This was exactly what happened when Apostle Paul proclaimed saying, "I die daily". God is willing to rest more on people who have many things, achieved a lot already but still have nothing to brag about. Always humble and respect others choices and opinion. Very productive, educated, sophisticated and also too approachable and accommodating. The least of the saints; is that individual who doesn't appear holy in his own eyes, standing on God's mercy and person. Sometimes back I saw in one of the Youngi Choi's book where He said, **"He began his day with God, one hour daily and in the process, yields all He is to God, appearing as a sinner in humility who hasn't even attained to any rank of righteousness"**. Now I knew he learnt that system from Apostle Paul, who said in today's scripture, *"To me, who are less than the least of all the saints, this grace was given, that I should preach among the gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ"*. "Less than the least of all the saints..." Can you agree to appear as the least even when you are sure you are the best/highest, but that is what God wants. Jesus was already the highest before he came to die for mankind. His death was not for anything 'Him' but was for everything men (You and I). Taking the least from the height of honour.

Some spouse have been wicked, always maltreating the other person emotionally and physically with mind that, yes, that is what ladies deserves or yes men are wicked, bearing a heart of revenge equipped by their hurt of the past; making their present spouse to suffer. See verse 7 of today's scripture says, **“O Lord though our iniquity testify against us, do thou it for thy name sake for our backsliding are many; we have sinned against thee”**. They are aware that they have sinned.

Gave her a hotel name and room. Asked her to go and pay for it and call them while she was in the room already waiting. Of course she did all that, then when the manager arrived, he looked at the sister, never said a word. Turned and was facing the wall, acting as though he was thinking. The sister pulled her clothes saying she was ready, the manager replied, "put back your clothes, being a sister who fears God is one of the reason why you should get the Job, because we as a company have agreed that it was only a sister who is faithful to God that we will employ. Your initial response was fine and we were glad we have found you but decided to wait for 6 – 8 weeks so we can call you back but you couldn't endure weather were you able to justify the love of God. The spider pursed for a little time and then listened because she was amused. “You better get out of this cornfield”, the little bug said, “The harvest is coming!” The spider smiled and said, “What is this harvest you are talking about ? I think you are just telling me astray”. But the little bug said, “Oh no, it is true. The owner is coming to harvest it soon. All the stalks will be knocked down and the corn will be gathered up. You will be killed by the giant machine if you stay here’. The news of the harvest seem to look strange to many, the point is, **“are you prepared for the harvest?”** If we live in view to the harvest our work and response to life will be different, if we live in view to the harvest our Christian life will be different. The place where your life is, is it a wheat or a torn. The compass of your living in God's graph, is it guided within the qualities of a wheat. Verse 30 of today's scripture says, *“Let both grow together until the time of harvest and in the time of harvest I will say to the reaper, gather ye together first the tares and bind them in bundles to burn them: but gather the wheat into my barn.”* The tares will be burnt at the lake of fire. There are specific seeds to harvest. Within your days of living covet a relationship with God that will align with the harvest. (Ephesians 5 vs. 27) says, *“That he might present it to himself a glorious church not having spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish”*, It should be a wheat not a tare,

TEXT: (John 2 vs. 16-20)

Whatever you hold and don't seized is not yours. When an opportunity or privilege is held and seized then you have conquered. HOLD and FOLD. To hold is the act of taking into your hands while to fold is the act of possession. What is held can be struggled by others but trying to get what is folded may end in a punch. Pearl S. Buck said, **“The young do not know enough to be prudent, and therefore they attempt the impossible-and achieve it, generation after generation.”** The road to success is plain: hold onto your passion continuously. What happens when your passion is not holding onto you? I believe that is where confidence comes in. Without confidence you cannot hold onto anything. Whatever you will use to win in life must first gain your trust. I believe that is what Henry David Thoreau was saying when he said, **“I have learned, that if one advances confidently in his dreams and endeavors to live the life he has imagined, he will meet with success.”** Jesus believed he was the messiah, the confidence was in him. He didn't get there yet but he believed that through him the relationship between man and God would change. He held to the passion and it was not enough, then he folded it. Remember folding is an act of possession. He held to his passion: **“I am here to transform the mind-set of man, to reconnect him to his Maker”**. He stood by the corner and achieved it. Seeing the evidence in verse 19 of today's scripture, he said, *“...Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up”*. It is not enough to hold unto that vision; fold it as well by building your trust on it. When you have folded a task in your arms; it an absolute readiness to achieve success or die while trying. Jesus was saying on this cause for which I came, I am willing to put my life on the line. He told them, *“kill me and after three days I will rebuild the system.”* (1 Corinthians 3 vs. 17): **“For you are the temple of God.”** It is essential to note that God is up to something when you are willing to hold and fold. Scream "I won't live less than a testimony." And someone said, **"It is better to die for something than live for nothing!"**

Verse 11 of today's scripture says, *"Behold I come quickly: hold that fast which thou hast, that no man take thy crown"*. When one loses what he is meant to hold fast, he/she will lose his crown as well. This suggests that a crown is attached to whatever God asks His own to hold. I am of the opinion that whatever we hold today is the structure of our testimony tomorrow. The salvation of today is anchored on making heaven tomorrow. Yesterday the Lord took us to the understanding of what it means to hold and fold; today I trust Him to take us through the outcome of holding and folding.

In ancient Persia, a king called upon all his wisest men and asked if there was a mantra he could follow that would help him get through any situation no matter the time, place or mood: in joy and sorrow, defeat and victory. After thinking for a long time on such puzzling question, the wise men gave the king a ring with an inscription on it. They advised him to not look at it until he was in desperate need. The king held the ring. After sometime, a neighbouring kingdom attacked them and the king was forced to flee with the remnant of his army until he was trapped at the end of the road in a deep valley. As he heard his enemies approaching he fell into despair over the hopeless situation. Then he remembered the ring. He looked down at it, at the inscription which read **'This too shall pass'**. The message affected him greatly. As he thought about it, he became calm and waited to see if his enemies would discover his whereabouts. Eventually the noise of horses receded and disappeared. The danger had passed. The warrior immediately regrouped his force and fought bravely in a counter attack. Eventually he overtook his enemies and regained his empire. He held the ring even in the midst of the battle. Anything God has attached to you, holds your victory. Hold your godly passion! Oh yes, hold that vision, the work, that idea because victory is within it. **Despite the last failure, don't lose your conviction to persevere.** Even if the journey is pleasant don't be lost to it; hold on and hold out. Recall: *"Hold that fast which thou hast"*. It is an open cheque: hold what you have. The question is what do I have presently? No one is empty, we all have something. Yes, you have your marriage, relationship, job, business, ministry and so on. The victory of the king was buried in the words on the ring. If he had forgotten the ring at home what would have happened? **Your victory is hidden in your passion, don't let it go yet. Pray in the Holy Ghost.**

Study verse 38 and 39 of today's scripture with me, where the word of God says, *"The field is the world, the good seed are the children of the Kingdom, but the tares are the children of the wicked one: (verse 39): The enemy that sowed them is the devil; the harvest is the end of the world; and the reaper are the angels"*. This is the summary of the harvest. You can either be a good seed or the tare. A good seed is good by its composition and effectiveness on earth and around. In continuation of our last story (You can read the part one story to have a clearer background) we have: The spider said, "I don't believe in harvests and giant machines that knocks down corn stalks, How can you prove this?" The little bug continued, "Just look at the corn. See how it is planted in rows. It proves this field was created by an intelligent designer". The spider laughed and mockingly said, "This field has evolved and has nothing to do with a creator. Corn always grows that way". The bug went on to explain. "Oh no, this field belongs to the owner who planted it, and the harvest is coming soon". The spider grimed and said to the little bug, "I don't believe you' and then the spider ate the little bug for lunch. A few days later there came a beautiful sunny day in the cornfield. The sky above was clear, and there was no wind at that afternoon so the spider was about to take a nap, she noticed some tick dusty clouds moving towards her. TEXT: (John 8 vs. 1-11)

He that wishes to be accepted by others or the public must see a need to accept himself first. You cannot be borrowed by another. When one denies himself; it is the compromise of the highest order. **Despite your deed which could make you not to trust yourself; be yourself!** Jesus was Himself. God is God all by Himself. The major point about being yourself is that it is essential you impress yourself first before you would be able to impress others. Having the understanding of the Gospel of Christ will strengthen our individual walk with God. The people you are trying to hide from, believing they are holier than you, do you really know them? You don't deserve any man's condemnation because Jesus the one who paid the debt of your sins with His life didn't condemn you. He made His opinion plain in today's scripture verse 10B "... He said unto her, woman where are those thine accusers? Hath no man condemned thee?" Accusation is not of God. You are not called as a preacher or pastor to accuse people. We are not called to judge the righteous, all our judgements should be based on the opinions of the scripture. Jesus inquired of her accusers. The scripture pointed at a particular person as the accuser of the brethren and that's the devil. (Revelation 12 vs. 10): 'Then I heard a loud voice in heaven, *"now salvation and the kingdom of our God and, the power of his Christ, have come, for the accuser of our brethren, who accused them before our God day and night, has been cast down"*'. Many of God's servants were not taken from the list of angels in heaven. Some had terrible pasts, oh yes, they accepted themselves and Jesus did not refuse or reject them either. He declared his position in verse 11B of our scripture today saying, *"...Neither do I condemn thee. Go and sin no more!"* You had a child out of wedlock, yes, Jesus isn't condemning you; all He is saying is that you need to accept yourself and level up in character. You did something that has made you look like the worst person on earth. Of course, people must condemn you, especially if you are in the body of Christ but **accept yourself. Never forget that Jesus, established love. (Continues Tomorrow).**

TEXT: (John 18 vs. 24-27), (John 21 vs. 19-23)

Lying about what you did is a crime, says the integrity you owe yourself. The reason for everything maybe deeper than you can reason. God doesn't think like we do. He doesn't trust your self-righteousness that's why He gave up Himself so that he can live in you; therefore when he looks at you He sees Himself. Observe the story below:

Jack decided to go skiing with his friend Bob. So they loaded up Jack's minivan and headed north. After driving for a few hours, they got caught in a terrible blizzard. So they pulled into a nearby farmland and asked the attractive lady who answered the door if they could spend the night? She explained, "I realise it is a terrible weather out there and I have this huge house all to myself, but I am recently widowed, I'm afraid the neighbours will talk if I let you stay in my house". Don't worry Jack said, 'We will be happy to sleep in the barn'. And if the weather breaks, we will be gone in the first light'. The lady agreed and the two men found their way to the barn and settled in for the night. Come morning, the weather had cleared, and they got on their way. They enjoyed a great weekend of skiing. But about nine months later. Jack got an unexpected letter from an attorney. It took him a few minutes to figure it out, but he finally determined that it was from the attorney of the attractive widow he had met on the ski weekend. He dropped in on his friend Bob and asked, "Bob do you remember that good-looking widow from the farm we stayed at on our ski holiday up north about 9 months ago?" "Yes I do", said Bob. "Did you happen to get up in the middle of the night, go up to the house and pay her a visit?" "Well, um, yes!" Bob said, a little embarrassed about being found out, "I have to admit that I did". And did you happen to give her my name instead of telling her your name? Bob's face turned red and he said, "yea, look, I'm sorry, buddy, I'm afraid I did. Why do you ask?" He accepted he was wrong and was willing to be punished but he was surprised by Jesus who came back and kept his past behind asking him to follow Him (Jesus) afresh. Peter must have thought within himself, Master it can't be me you are calling; no, not after I have denied you thrice. But Jesus called him the second time saying, "FOLLOW ME" (Verse 21B). **When you accept yourself, then you can accept Christ.**

TEXT: (Psalm 103 vs. 7 – 22)

Oh God I thank you for the privilege to ponder on your place of insight today. I want to remind you that one of the secret of exploit in life is knowing the ways of God. When the way of God is known struggle reduces. Knowing the ways of God also saves from satanic damages. To know the way of God is to walk in the path of wisdom that is not questionable by any form of human theory. Whoever the Lord wants to take far, I believe one of the first thing He does is to make his way known to him/her. Yes, it reveals His mind and His will for you. The ways of God implies, coming out of your own understanding and historical knowledge of God to do what He has revealed to you about Himself. Verse 7 of today's scripture says, "*He made known His ways unto Moses, his acts unto the children of Israel*". Someone would ask what does the ways of God imply, it implies fearing Him and doing His will. Moses commented on the acts of God because God's way was made known to him. One of the prayers to pray is to pray in the tone of David who said, "*Show me thy ways, O Lord; teach me thy paths*". To see the ways of God is to walk pass some satanic confrontations. When you know the ways of God it brings satisfaction and fulfilment in your walk with Him. When you realise His ways it makes you to trust His manifold wisdom and relax in His limitlessness. The ways of God commands His power in action. The knowledge of God brings result in the expected channel. **The help of God is hidden within His knowledge.** People perish for lack of knowledge. The more of Him you know, the more of Him you see. I believe this can clear the confusion of many of us why Apostle Paul prayed, "*That I may know Him, and the power of His resurrection, and the fellowship of His suffering...*" (Philippians 3 vs. 10). **I don't know how much of Him you have known that is making you appear like you have known Him enough.**

**Does God take a break in His desire to save lives?** As you ponder on the question above, I gladly welcome you to the zone of the Almighty God! Jesus Christ! To him that evangelizes to what extent will you ignore a soul and count it as one given to hell. It is the will of God that all men come to the knowledge of God, becoming like him and living by His principles. There is a wall you need to push, the problem is not the wall but the problem is the need to get beyond the wall. So after pushing the wall for a long time and you realised that nothing changed then you need an idea to get through the wall. You can fly above it, you can go to the end of it and cross but the point is that you need to get to the other side. **“Never, ever give up. Don't give up. Don't allow it to happen. If there is a concrete wall in front of you, go through it, go over it, go around it, but get to the other side of the wall”**. Same is applicable to soul winning and pursuit. How long can you evangelize to someone before giving up on the person? I believe this juice from verse 14 of our first scripture will flavour a soul, *“Now we exhort you, brethren warn them that are unruly, comfort the feeble minded, support the weak, be patient towards all men.”* Patience is a state of negligence that believes that something will still turn out to be good or better than it had been. Patience though does not permit pushing a wall that can never fall. It doesn't speak on believing in a dead vision instead of initiating a new strategy. I have seen pastors spend time on souls that have rejected God. Recall God's word in today's scripture which says, *“A man that is an heretic after the first and second admonition reject”* (KJV). Just take a look at the MSG explanation of it: *“Warn a quarrelsome person once or twice, but then be done with him. It's obvious that such a person is out of line and rebellious against God.”* Even Jesus said, if any reject the word you bring stamp your feet on the sand for that shall speak against the fellow on the judgement day. Don't be discouraged by the attitude of a soul you wish to win. **If it tends to be difficult try someone else.**

TEXT: (Luke 6 vs. 1-11)

**“Men make history and not the other way round. It is not a must that your opinion must align with that of every other person. It takes courage to be exceptional. The time you start living in agreement with the general opinion, it becomes a challenge to the unique assignment God called you to do. Whatever that is generally accepted isn't always the best. There is a unique thought God has planted in some of us that only by boldness can we be able to introduce it to others and hence creating a change. **It is very rare to witness one who created a change that is in uniform to the existing opinion.** Don't seek for men's approval, that's God's word to someone. Do what your thought has agreed with God on. Your destiny is registered with God alone to the ignorance of those who surround you. Jesus made it clearer in Luke 6 vs. 26 when He said, *“Woe unto you when all men shall speak well of you! For so did their fathers to the false prophets”*. **“Greatness is not found in generality.”** Stand your ground!

See again verse 7 of today's scripture, *“And the scribes and the Pharisees watched him whether he would heal on the Sabbath day, that they might find an accusation against him”*. Imagine if Jesus behaved himself, not to offend their imagination, today it might still be a crime to heal on the Sabbath; but presently the joy of any godly meeting is the level of healing that takes place in it. It is like Jesus was making us to understand that the presence of God doesn't just celebrate Sabbath but brings deliverance to men. The joy of your future is in your decisions of today. A positive change yet to come is waiting for your determination and boldness to take place. **'A miracle is when you take actions on your written goals and work hard to create it. Transform your dreams into reality by writing your goals, taking action and making them happen. This is the shortest recipe to tap success'** (Mark F. Lamoure). Jesus replied in verse 9 of today's scripture saying, *“...is it lawful on the Sabbath day to do good, or to do evil? To save life or to destroy it?”* It is not a must that your actions must agree with their opinions but it should be a must that you do good. Rejoice in the LORD!

To the living there is hope: “For to Him that is joined to all the living there is hope: for a living dog is better than a dead lion”. Don't feel like it is a good thing to die now. There are people who died a week or months after their loved ones died, it is not because it was their time yet but they were like why should life continue without this person. Why should I continue living when I have lost this? The time of man on earth is but a short time, too short that it passes away like a wind. Assignment: Thank God for life and appreciate yourself irrespective of how life has been on you! Confess in opposition to any negative thing you have said about yourself.

He calls us every day of the year saying come unto me. There was a 9 year old boy whose house was in the poor area of the community. A church had a bus ministry that came knocking on his door one Saturday afternoon. The kid came to answer the door and greeted the bus pastor. The bus Pastor asked if his parents were home, and the small boy told him that his parents leave the house every weekend and leaving him at home to take care of his little brother. It was unbelievable considering what the Pastor heard from the boy. The relationship between man and God is the most amazing in all the universe. It is very simple to engage in it; imagine how the small boy who had never been to a church, raised by ungodly parents became a born again Christian, ready for rapture just because of that prayer that took less than three minutes. You don't just come unto God to be saved of your sins, you also come unto him to be healed of your wounds. You come to him to be directed for the day. To be helped in life. You also come unto him to be delivered from marital crisis. You don't come to Him once and for all, you come to him daily; for every issue connected to living. You don't read God's word or COF just to hear God, but to come to him in surrendering and humbleness of heart. Jesus explained in verse 28 of today's first scripture saying, “*Are you tired? Worn out? Burned out of religion? Come to me. Get away with me and you will recover your life. I will show you how to take a real rest*” (MSG). Only Jesus can give the real rest. Do you have anyone going through crisis? Seize this opportunity and draw them unto the giver of rest to all. Lift your hand and take the song, '**Unto Jesus, I surrender, unto thee I freely give...**'

I had money remaining after that day and I continued to give my mother money after that day. She never lacked money again. Today, the young man is the CEO of Chelsea group limited. A company worth billions of Naira. Speak to God and feel that He heard. Speak and receive the idea of what to do to provoke the Miracle. Digest verse 8A of today's scripture saying, "He raiseth up the poor out of the dust and lifteth up the begger from the dunghill", God is the lifter of persons, Assignment: 1. Tell God today that He should lift you for the sake of those looking up to you. 2. Behave like you visited God.

He kept the plate on the floor and stood on it, and as he stood there he lifted up his head and said, "Jesus, I don't have anything to give you today, but just me. I give you me!"

Verse 4 of today's scripture revealed the word of Jesus when he said, "Suffer the little children, and forbid them not to come unto me: for of such is the kingdom of heaven..." The child had nothing to give God but himself. What have you given God that is outside yourself? He values nothing more than yourself. It is not time to choose to struggle over church positions. It is time to offer up yourself to God. God is asking someone, 'what is the essence of your offering when you have not offered your whole self?' Have you offered yourself to Him excluding your business and finances? No, that's not how to do it. Make Him the Lord of all

TEXT: (1 Kings 18 vs. 40-46), (Mark 4 vs. 35-36)

Actions are taken based on the expectation around the person acting. When an expectation is becoming a reality a step is taken to adjust or accommodate the latest line of manifestation. Expectation ceases to be a reality when the proper line of action is neglected. You don't plan for the air and go below the earth. You don't hope for success and walk towards failure. While Jesus was hoping to step into Gadarenes to perform the act of God and he told his disciples in verse 35 of today's second scripture saying, "... let us pass over unto the other side". Within this season God is calling on someone to step up to the other side. You need to adjust yourself to accommodate where you are hoping to be. You need to adjust yourself to embrace the new level. Whichever level you are hoping for, it is time you channel your living according to the demands of that side.

Some believers are too good and impressive that they refuse growth, you stay in one place but God is leading you to something and you choose to remain there just to be getting accolades and applause from men. Greatness meets no man to change his status but men act great to attract greatness. My Father in the Lord, Doctor Paul Enenche said, "You can't attract what you attack." You witness what you expect not the other way around. **"No dream is too big. No challenge is too great. Nothing we want for our future is beyond our reach"** (Donald Trump). A little analysis of Elijah's practices that brought him victory from today's scripture will reveal faith and hope. Elijah said unto Ahab, Get thee up, eat and drink; for there is a sound of abundance of rain. He heard it, not from God but within himself through his imagination. **There was no sign of rain but sound; he heard it alone.** If it was a sign at least Ahab would have seen it also. You don't grow up in life by signs, you grow up by the sound you hear. Are you hearing the sound of your wedding banquet this year? Oh yes, somebody just heard the sound of business exploit and exploration of wealth. May God open your ears to hear! "Then the servant after the seventh time said, there is a little cloud as little as human hand; even the servant did not believe in the prayers. How can he behold something as little as human hand, millions of miles away; but that's not Elijah's problem, all he wanted was a sign despite how little it would be. He magnified it and then said to Ahab, run because the rain is coming. It takes the sound you hear to produce the sign you want. Move to the next level of your life because it is approaching you with great speed

TEXT: (Isaiah 2 vs. 12 – 17)

Thanks be to God who has brought us before His face today. Men are brought down from the place of honour God has revealed to them as a result of pride. It takes honour and reverence of God to have what only God can give. I have met men who expressed their pride in many forms. There are people who are less careful to glorify God at the work of miracles instead of them to honour God they channel the honour to themselves. **Instead of them to honour God, they limit the honour and keep it to themselves.** God does not invest where He does not reap. God is not a waster of glory. Today's scripture pointing the interest of God said in verse 17, *"the loftiness of men shall be bowed down, and the haughtiness of men shall be brought low; the Lord above will be exalted in that day."* If the name of God is with you ensure you return those glory to Him. Do you always accredit the peace of your home to the fact that you are knowledgeable on home and family matters? Do you accredit it to yourself or to your intelligence; the success you have enjoyed in your place of business, it is very important and necessary we note that God likes his honour. There are pastors God has showed some grace and they left it to themselves. Their testimonies is always I, I and I. The pride of men brings them low. When a man starts giving Himself what is God's, God will personally bring him down or hand him over to destruction. *"For whosoever exaulteth Himself shall be abased; and that humbleth himself shall be exalted"*. Sharing what God has done for your or through you is very necessary because it makes the devil to hide his face, therefore don't channel the glory of God to your intelligence. *"Likewise, ye younger, submit yourselves unto the elder, yea, all of you be subject one to another, and be clothed with humility; for God resisteth the proud and giveth grace to the humble"* (1 Peter 5 vs. 5). God in His moves resists the proud. **In His mightiness and strength He makes things beautiful and amazing in His own nature and ways.**

TEXT: (1 king 13 vs. 4-6)

The one who induces meaning to our words is the Holy Ghost. I congratulate you for being a part of today's word from the throne of grace. God's word is with meaning; each part of the scripture means a lot of things based on the insight you catch through the Holy Spirit. The same is applicable to the words we speak within the atmosphere of the kingdom of God. Let me share a few examples with us; God has been able to reveal himself to us through His various moves and we return all glory to Him. During one of our meetings in 2018 a sister testified of how her son's swollen scrotum was healed. The abnormality was noticed after a surgical operation. She was the previous Sunday evening hoping to return to hospital by Monday with her child to know what exactly could be the cause. But that Sunday as the servant of God was proclaiming an end to all manner of infirmities, the swollen scrotum dried up that she couldn't find any sign of it. All glory returned to God. Indeed it is a wonder.

Another sister testified to an associate of this vision when he was distributing COF to her, she said, during one of the meetings God's servant proclaimed disappearances of tumour and lumps. Though she never took it seriously, until she got home to notice that the tumour was gone forever. It is the Lord's doing and it is marvellous in our sight.

I also recall an incident that took place during my secondary school days. A friend of mine came to iron his church cloth in my corner; incidentally it was the day they were to appoint new executives in their church. He was the least to be considered. I spoke to him saying, "Dear, iron the cloth carefully because you are emerging a president today." I wasn't serious while I was saying that but he returned in the afternoon as the new president; walked up to me and asked "How did you know I would become the president?" All thanks to God who considers us, though we may be the least qualified. God is saying to someone, don't decree meaninglessly; mean what you say. Are you battling with an occult man, tell him to his hearing that his days are numbered if he continues in his evil act against you. God likes challenges, He likes contest. You don't judge the wicked in secret and expect him to be destroyed openly. When you judge him openly, you produce open result. Learn to say something under the sponsorship of God and see them happen. Verse 4B of today's scripture says, "...that he put forth his hand from the altar saying, lay hold on him. And his hand, which he put forth against him, dried up, so that he could not pull it in again to him". Say something today meaning it and God will bring it to pass. Enter into covenant with God and give out the next COF to friends and others: ask him three things you want Him to do and see them come to fulfilment.

TEXT: (Job 36 vs. 7 – 12)

I still want to remind someone who cares to know that God in His infinity has always want to reward discipline in as much as prayer in its weight is highly effective but hard work is effective too. I am sure and certain that God in His wisdom does not entrust anything upon the lazy. His intelligence does not sponsor people to foolishness and loses. A wise man's wisdom is found in his calculations to make things fine. If you don't want to make things fine then give up to them, give up to it. You have no genuine reason to give less than the average. Life is not a place to watch things happen. **“There are categories of people in life, those who watch things happen, those who make them happen and those who don't even know what is happening”**. Which group do you belong to? Any height of life is possible but the point is which one is your mind yielding to. Every place of life is equally reachable but the point is to which extent can you push yourself to move. The truth is obvious that it is not everybody who wants to be known, it is not everybody who wants to get high or acquainted with high positions. I have come across people who are sluggish with what they do, only making reference that it will be fine and better. Inasmuch as I trust God to be my help all the time I am still sure and certain that His help is to replace my effort, with grace, frustration with Hope and understanding. Verse 10 of today's scripture says, “In verse 10 saying, *“He openeth also their ear to discipline, and command that they return from iniquity”*. Ears are open to discipline. Is it not vital to understand that God tells people what to do and ties their upliftment to doing it. The point is, you knowing exactly what God would want you do, know where he is sending you is also the necessary goal. I think you need to digest this; **“Only put off until tomorrow what you are willing to die having left undone”**.

Even when you have gotten enough reasons to give up your life, contemplating on committing suicide, remember you are in the field. As you fight to survive plan for a future, hope for it. Learn not to be disappointed by planning what next if eventually disappointment comes.

God gave the Israelites a key to survive in the field when he told them saying in verse 19-20 of our scripture, *"When you mount an attack on a town and the siege goes on a long time, don't start cutting down the trees swinging your axe against them. Those trees are your future food, don't cut them down. Are trees soldiers who come against you with weapons? The exception can be those trees which don't produce food; you can chop them down and use the timbers to build siege engines against the town that is resisting you until it falls"*. God was practically telling them that you aren't in the field to die, don't be eaten up by that condition. I think it is clearer with KJV where it says, *'...for the tree of the field is man's life'*. Jehovah wants you to find a life support while you are in the field. Don't end your day badly even if it appears bad. **There is a tree you need to keep for the future and Jesus is the tree.**

TEXT: (Acts 9 vs. 6 – 11)

Oh Lord, have your way is a prayer of principled people asking god to do what only Him can do at every point, they try to look up to Him. Saying Lord have your way with faith is an invitation to the grace the Lord in all Himself represents. There are times and season the place of God should not be undermined. The first way to see God have His is by being willing to give to Him all that He demands of us, to enable him have his way in full. People are very damaging when they run by their senses. Lord have your way is the prayer many of us pray when we don't know what next to do. When we have run out of options, but even in the midst of our calculativeness and wisdom, figuring out almost all, it is still necessary that the Lord has His way. When God have His way He shows up through the channel you never expected. But I had seen too many impoverished people who depended on taxi as their only means of transportation. Unless a situation smelled of danger, I always waited at the door. This passenger might be someone who needs my assistance. I reasoned to myself so I walked to the door and knocked. "Just a minute", answered a frail, elderly voice. After a long pause the door opened. A small woman in her 80s stood before me. She was wearing a print dress and a pillbox hat with a veil printed on it, like somebody out of a 1940s movie. By her side was a small nylon suitcase. Would you carry my bag out to the car? She said. I took the suitcase to the cab, then turned to assist the woman. She took my arm and we walked slowly towards the cab. She kept thanking me for my kindness.

To be a cab man isn't the same job as to serve as a maid or old people's treatment; but the cab man was calm not because he had nothing else to do but because he knew that it was a chance to pay his debt. Some of us are so busy looking for money every day without seeing the need to reach out to our parents. It is a shame for a parent who can be taken care of with just a little, to lack up to the point of lacking what to eat. These people do not need much but just a little, and you are equally blessed for doing that. You are still a student, they pay your bills, when last did you check on them, if it is not to ask for money. Digest verse 15 of today's scripture, *"For so is the will of God, that with well doing, ye may put to silence the ignorance of foolish men"*. Thank you Jesus.

She showed me the building where she had once worked as an elevator operator. We drove through the neighbourhood where she and her husband had lived when they were newlyweds. She had me pull up in front of a furniture warehouse that had once been a ballroom where she had gone dancing as a girl. I took her to her destination and she was carried with wheelchair by two orderlies. She wanted to pay but I refused because I knew that may be her last tour before she leaves this planet. **You don't enter people's life except you live patiently. You don't make an impact unless you live selflessly. God bless you richly!**

I welcome you to the very presence of God, the one who has been forever. Many individuals fell victims of mocking the dead. Mounting pressure on himself to provide for those who don't mind how he survives. Do you know that some persons who were killed for robbery engaged on it to prove a point to some insignificant folks. Some persons in prison today are there because they are bent on proving a point that doesn't represent their esteem. Pressure is a word that is misused in our vocabulary. When you start thinking in the direction of pressure it is because you have started thinking in the direction of failure. Lose any form of pressure that is a threat to you. 

It is possible for people to question your credibility and go all the way to satisfy their quest that you are imperfect, and most of the times these things are done to satisfy their ego and their pride that they are better and more credible. Some brothers fire have been criticized as over-sabi, and he likes to show himself. While some sisters giving sincerely has been criticized as trying to gain the Pastor's attention. Some persons sincere labour in an organisation has been criticized as an eye service to gain the bosses attention but whichever way it is, whatever that is godly and genuinely done with a sincere heart, if should be affected by anything should increase and not decrease. Today's scripture was clear when it says in verse 5, "He (Joseph) went with Mary his fiancé, who was pregnant". How can a fiancée being pregnant before the actually wedding/marriage be accredited as one of the processes of God? How do you reconcile that God who knows order and rule can chose to introduce himself through a humanly known disordered process or marriage. Many times not being spiritually sensitive we have criticized the intelligence of God using our own understanding. Joseph told no one that he was not responsible for the child. "Oh yes, that would have worsen the situation, but he kept it to himself. **Sometimes allow the critics, don't explain anything, they are part of God's making**, but by all means maintain Godliness with all level of doggedness and your criticizers **criticises God and is not your fault that they do. God bless you!**

Reading the scripture and adjusting the sayings on it, looks easy to us sometimes but more to that the Lord wants to take us to a new understanding. Do you know that while Joseph travelled with Mary that they were not welcomed by his people because Joseph did not owe up to them that he wasn't the father of the child. As easy as that portion of the scripture is to read, he was criticized, he was rejected, they didn't even have a house to sleep in and on Mary's womb was the saviour of the whole universe. Those privileges and opportunities were they withdrawn from you by the virtue of criticism or that the right thing you do does not align with the fact that they are still the will of God. Verse 7 of today's scripture says, "*And she brought forth her first born son, and wrapped him in a swaddling clothes, and laid him in a manger; because there was no room for them in the Inn.*" They had no room! With the arrival of the owner of the whole universe there was no room! This explains why there was no relative of Joseph who was present to welcome the child when he was born. God who is never taken unawares had to send farmers, strangers and then wise men from the east. **God's glory can be in that place where men or relatives despise.** It doesn't matter what the will of God might cost you, you are in for lifting. The Almighty shall arise and arrest every situation that looks alike in the name of Jesus, Amen! God shall send help for you from every unexpected areas of life in Jesus name, Amen! **Assignment:** Look carefully around you and discover the sincere assignments of God around you and the difficulty attached to them. **On the difficult declare God's help and intervention.**

Verse 2 of today's scripture says, *“It is the glory of God to conceal a matter, but the glory of kings is to search out a matter”*. God is waiting for your approach to search out for matters related to your destiny. It is very necessary you develop a movement plan with God. Prepare the January 2022 fasting and prayer plan, **starting from 3rd-23rd January 2022: 21 day fasting plan.**

Be humble, respectful and honour those who are authorities and of influence on earth but not to the insult and limitation of yourself and grace as you live, let not your life run by people's down grading of you. Keeping yourself in such position is what attracts God's jealousy against you. God by himself fights those who has made fellow men their source of strength and lifting. The opinion of God about this was well stated in (Jeremiah 17 vs. 5): *"Thus saith the Lord; curse be the man that trusteth in man, and maketh flesh his arm, and whose heart departeth from the Lord"*. You see, in as much as God uses people to bless us, our greatest expectation within that angle is that we trust God to bless us using people. **This equally makes you not to be stalked because when one is not available to help the Lord lifts another.** God bless you, Amen!

God said audibly, **"Thou shall not suffer a witch to live"** (Exodus 22 vs. 18). Though we have enemies who are human beings but be sure of what God says before praying. Don't go bad because of someone else's progress. Today's scripture verse 27 says, *"Whoso diggeth a pit shall fall therein: and he that rolleth a stone it will return upon him"*. I speak to you, any witchcraft operation against your life and destiny is hereby terminated forever, in Jesus name, Amen! I announce you are free from their manipulations.



**“Living in the spirit means that I trust the Holy Spirit to do in me what I cannot do myself”.** This is completely different from the life I would naturally live of myself. Each time I am faced with a new demand from the Lord. I look to him to do in me what he requires of me. It is not a case of trying but of trusting and resting in him. A spirit man is without doubt that man whom the Lord has possessed. It takes the Spirit to dwell in the supremacy of God and what He represents. Spirit is only associated with the truth. The spirit cannot be deceived. Yes, it is the spirit that keeps the record and accounts of internal dealings with God. **Someone can fake God and His ways many times deceiving people but you cannot deceive the Spirit.** This brings us to the knowledge why Jesus said, *“God is spirit: and they that worship Him must worship Him in spirit and in truth”* (John 4 vs. 24). On rare cases we see the scripture pointing to the word ‘must’. There is no way out of it, it is a must to find God by the Spirit. This explains the reason why many of us are having few results after our prayers. We didn't bring the spirit at play, it is the spirit that draws God. A spiritual man is the man who hosts God by His Spirit and today's scripture shall be fulfilled in such a person's life, where it says in (Luke 10 vs. 16): *“He that heareth you, heareth me; and he that despiseth you, despiseth me; and he that despiseth me despiseth He that sent me”*. This is the point where you become the extension of God in every possible way. It is highly impossible to carry God and not carry His royalty. You are indispensable and your voice is never a noise. The one whom you follow is the elshedie and he that plans your destruction shall die. **I speak to someone let those who pang up against you perish in Jesus name, Amen!**

A brother attended the meeting who is also a COF director with moody face. Before the program started he told me that he lost his phone and most importantly the content on the phone is too heavy to lose, he was moody. I felt for him but cannot help the situation, but during the worship section; God said to me, "Tell him the phone shall be found tomorrow. I doubted myself, added with the number of people present looking and listening. I didn't tell him anything. During the prayer section God took us to prophetic moment, when it was his turn, God again said through me to him, "By this time tomorrow what is lost will be found, so I declared it out and everybody heard". At that point a lot of persons he related to had already known that he lost his phone. The phone actually fell from a tricycle and was taken by an area boy, who can steal people's phone and money in a broad day light. The top details in the phone has been reset, memory card cleared. They did all that because they wanted to sell the phone. The next day the boy who was with the phone called back a number that called the phone and brought it back and collected nothing in return. What can your faith receive? Today's scripture verse 9 says, "This man heard Paul speaking. Paul observing him initially and seeing that he had faith to be healed. (Verse 10): Said with a loud voice, "Stand up straight on your feet!" And he leaped and walked". Faith get everything; God's word assured us the fulfilment of everything; yes, He assured the provision of all things. Just use faith and have them. Use faith and get them; let your faith be established in Jesus name. I speak to someone at this very dying minute 2019 will arrive with a surprising testimony for you in Jesus name, Amen!

Verse 13 of today's scripture says, “*For who knoweth what is good for man in this life, all the days of his vain life which he spendeth as a shadow*”. Among the youth these day there is a high level of drug abuse, even to the female gender. Many persons in various universities have given themselves to drugs. There are individuals who have killed another or assisted the plan of killing someone else. There are ways of life that results to termination of glory and the reduction of goodness. You must come to that point where your life is valued, where your living can take an upper hand in goodness and righteousness. God bless you richly, Amen!

There are individuals who have met some life disadvantages which has kept them sorrowful for a long time. Imagine a woman who spent most of her marital time as a widow and a very short time as married. I knew of a woman whose first son died few years after graduating as an engineer. This happened in the 80s; then being a graduate in my country was a big achievement with many opportunities to succeed. Then you don't look for Job, Job looks for you once you graduate with a good grade. In fact the diseased best friend later became the governor of their state. This will tell you the kind of opportunity that was exposed to this young man if he was living. I sat near the mother for a long time on many occasions and she laments of the death of her destined son, who was the first graduate in their kindred. His death was a product of poison. It was indeed a sorrowful event for this woman. There are people whose shops caught fire which represents 5, 10, 15 and in some cases 20 years labour and they reduced from millionaire to survivors. It is indeed a sorrowful event. I can recall saying this one time in the previous COF, “**Even when your feel like quitting, even if you do not feel like keeping this life of yours stable, live it for the sake of those that desire what you live as life**” (Isaac Chidolue). Sorrows of the past shall be replaced with Joy in Jesus name, Amen! There is no sorrow within the territory of a girl who had disappointments in marriage and later married a man far better than all those who disappointed her. God promised to remove sorrow on today's first scripture when He said, “*And the ransomed of the Lord shall return and come to Zion with songs and everlasting Joy upon their heads: they shall obtain joy and gladness and sorrow and sighing shall flee away*”. Today's second scripture added. “*Therefore remove sorrow from thy heart, and put away evil from thy flesh: for childhood and youth are vanity*”. Clear any form of sorrow from your heart. **I decree you shall know no sorrow in Jesus name, Amen! Get the new COF.**

I don't know what may seem of your life presently but trusting God really goes a very long way. It is generally hard to produce an interesting result from God where trust for God does not exist. Do you really trust Him that those days of difficulty, poverty and limitation are over forever? I can recall a Chinese story that told of a woman who goes to the bank of the river every morning fetching water and pouring back to the sea when the reason behind her actions was investigated, it was gathered that she was doing that believing that one day she might be lucky to fetch back her son who was swallowed by the river. The son went to overseas to study, he succeeded and graduated excellently well. The day he returned, everybody was expecting him, inclusive of his mum and family members. He arrived through a ship, saw them and they saw him as he was about leaving the boat smiling at him and he was smiling back approaching them. He was surprise by the love of those who came out to welcome him but before he could reach them, he fell into the ocean and his body was not recovered. Sorrow is a device of the devil to keep people forever wounded. Therefore I agree with you in the name of Jesus saying, **“You shall not witness any cause of sorrow around your life and destiny, Amen!”** Today's first scripture verse 11B says, *“Zion; and everlasting joy shall be upon their head: they shall obtain gladness and joy [and] sorrow and mourning shall flee away”*. We walked out today with a baby boy who had not a single thing wrong with him, his vision, his hearing, his brain scan. “A miracle is something that seems impossible but happens anyway. Most times the option to trust God is the only standing option. As a human many times it I really hard to trust him but considering that there is no other choice in front of us we trust him knowing that He fails not. What exactly has taken your trust away from Him, take out time today and cry to him, remind him that he is your only hope. “Lord, if you leave me, I am as good as waste”. “If not for you Lord my life would have been useless, you tell him that the future you boast about is all in his hand and your boast in him. Verse 4 of today's scripture says, “I sought the Lord, and he heard me and delivered me from all my fears”. I was afraid but then I sought the Lord, then I saw the reasons why I fear no more! Two (2) years after we left secondary school some of those notorious boys were on fire for God. In fact one of them that looks like their leader is now burning for the Lord and He attended one of our convention the previous time. It is indeed by grace and by no man's work. “...called us with Holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was given to us in Christ Jesus before time began” (Today's second scripture). **Any godly work not accredited to grace is false.**

Recently, I was on my personal evangelism walk; by then I was almost fulfilled having preached to some decent young men who knows me; but there was this need to talk to some other persons, then I noticed this young man smoking weed, then I purposely followed him without his notice and within a short distance I tapped him, he turned putting up a smile to extend greetings to me as someone who knows him, then I said, "I like you bro and I would want to be your friend, meanwhile my name is Isaac". He was happy hearing those words from me. He revived from his smoke. Many times people shift from God for their self-justified reasons but it takes this kind of God's love to restore them to the core. What will be the hope of the common man whom God tends to lift if the church starts segregating, hating, neglecting even the one who appears as the worst of men. In verse 17 of today's scripture God's word says, "But I am poor and needy; yet the Lord thinketh upon me. Thou art my help and my deliverer make no tarring, O my God". If the poor knows that the Lord thinketh upon him, why shouldn't we so relate with people that they will start seeing the love of God from us. That they will start seeing his hand in the church. It should be obvious that the love of God is our basic identity. You love the lowly by thinking about them. When was the last time you thought about helping someone lesser than you are, by giving them food and other basic things of life, **when was the last time you saw a sinner and loved them with the love of the Lord! 2022 Fasting starts from the 3rd - 23rd January; get ready!**

TEXT: (Matthew 26 vs. 7 – 16)

Anger is sometimes sponsored by hatred, jealousy, or misunderstanding of the truth, whichever way, anger is a bad omen. I trust God on your behalf to arrive to that place where the response of God is obvious and known. I heard someone share the story about one of his relative who had misunderstanding with someone in a business environment. This happened and he was angry, so angry that he was stammering while speaking and interrogating the fellow. At a time they heard a sound like gun short and other people there were witness to that, not long after that the angry man was rushed to the hospital and reaching the hospital he was confirmed dead, saying that his heart bursted. Anger increase the blood pressure and most times influences the mind as well. When people listen to their anger, they are later left with heavy regrets. What you are doing today, is it sponsored by anger or is it the only thing you can do for now? Think before getting yourself caged by things that does not worth it. Like we saw in the life of Judas Iscariot, this was exactly what played out. In verse 14 – 15 of today's scripture: "*then one of the twelve called Judas Iscariot, went unto the chief priests*". He went to the chief priests after the alabaster box was broken on Jesus' feet. After his managerial idea on the need to feed the poor instead of celebrating Jesus was rejected. Satan planted anger in his heart sponsored by jealousy and greediness which eventually led to his destruction. The basic reason why you are angry could just be an implantation of the enemy. Anger most times are the seeds of the enemy to limit you from where God is taking you. At a time I found myself almost angry about what someone does which excites me in the past then I knew that something was wrong. I went and prayed about it and the anger left and my excitement returned, then I knew that satan plants anger in people to limit their access to glory. **God bless you richly. Amen! Happy New year in advance.**

TEXT: (Nahum 2 vs. 11 – 12)

A strong man can be a weak man in his dwelling place. If our dwelling places can speak, I think it can give an accurate analysis of whom we are; and when the devil wants to handicap a man he makes him lose strength and value from his dwelling place. The strength you maintain at your dwelling place determines the strength you will manifest outside your dwelling place. A man who is confident at his dwelling place is the same man that will manifest an unusual strength and energy outside his dwelling place. Your dwelling place is “your mind”; overcoming the unseen battles of the mind, standing firm despite the humiliation that may occur from within, be brave on the outside world. John Steinbeck in his book the “Grapes of Wrath” which he described as 'mediocre', he said, “no one else knows my lack of ability the way I do. I am pushing against it all the time. Sometimes I seem to do a good little piece of work, but when it is done it slides into mediocrity”. Now the book he described as 'mediocre' when released became an instant sensation, going on to sell 14 million copies. It was the book that won him the Pulitzer Prize and the Noble Prize on literature. The quote above from Steinbeck wasn't that he doubted himself but he pushed against his doubt, lack of ability and against his frustration. Those who doubted themselves the most often did the best. “No warrior who is confident enough about victory in his mind, is also without doubt like, what of if I fail, but his boldness towards victory seems more visible because he has allowed his confidence to swallow his doubt.” Do not pray for an easy life, pray for the strength to endure a difficult one, because no great life is experienced without difficulties. Jesus is the greatest but not with an easy life. At a time He wanted to give up, but all He could see was the process to greatness which was Calvary. Verse 11B of today's scripture says, “Where the lion, even the old lions walked, and the lions whelp (Young lion), and none made thee afraid?” A lot of discouraging thoughts will emerge from your mind to stop you from doing that one thing that holds the key to your greatness. Guide your dwelling place (Mind) because that's where your victory is built.

TEXT:(Psalm 89 vs. 24 – 27)

I welcome you before the one who is called the Almighty all by Himself. Many times people chose to hate you for a reason best known to them, but you should use the hate. For being hated is a very good reason why you should be determined to prove the devil wrong. When you stand above your haters that is the point God is willing to support you in the path of excellence. See the story below: George McLaurin, was the first black to be admitted into the University of Oklahoma in 1948. He was asked to be sitting in a corner far from his white class mates. He worked hard to be one of the three best students of the university. This is what he said; “Some colleagues would look at me like I was an animal, no one would give me a word, the teacher seemed like they were not even there for me, nor did they always take my questions when I asked. But I devoted myself so much that afterwards, they began to look for me to give them explanations and to clear their questions.” Lesson: “**Forcing yourself to be accepted by people is a waste of time. Just focus and add value to yourself and people shall come seeking your help**”. This is similar to the popular story of Joseph we know in the scripture of how he was hated but rescued by the Lord: that he was in a position higher than his haters. (Verse 24) of today's scripture says, “*But my faithfulness and my mercy shall be with him: and in my name shall his horn be exalted*”. In the name of the Lord is where our horn is exalted. By the insight of that word I speak to you, **'those places where you were rejected, you shall be accepted in Jesus name, amen!'** I speak to you, **those that gave up on you shall see the hand of God on you**, oh yes casualties around your life and Destiny are frustrated already in Jesus name, Amen! For being hated like Leah the Lord shall favour you! Yes, our God is also the God of the hated and your haters shall be silent for ever.

I have met ladies who said, even though he has not spoken to me back then, I know he was my husband. Of course they made this confession after they were married by the same man they spoke about. How could they have known that someone is their husband when they didn't picture about their marriage. **“Studying the scripture gives you the right picture of the best future you propose to have”** (Isaac Chidolue). Verse 19 of today's scripture says, *“Jesus answered and said unto them, Destroy the temple, and in three days I will raise it up”*. Jesus was having the picture of the cross. He didn't just die for mankind but He pictured himself as the only source to man's redemption. He had the knowledge of the future he was running after. You cannot grab the future you didn't picture about. As 2021 is remaining 2 days, what is the picture of your 2022? How well have you planned the continuation of the task you didn't finish in 2021? What's your whole picture of 2022? That is what will form the content of your prayer points. Ask God to give you the right mind to have the right picture. So many persons are now dreaming for a better 2022 but until you make the dreams visible and specific it has no meaning yet. Pick up a pen and write down your pictures of next year. Jesus dreamt of the cross, He pictured it as three days of temple rebuild and just as he pictured, so was it. So many temples across the world are built for Him, and will be built by Him. **Picture a glorious year end.**

A careful person must always avoid dangers and set ups. Someone may say, it is only the Lord that can preserve someone but beyond that carefulness cannot be undermined.
